It could be as easy as sending a confirmation from your insurance company stating which services are covered, and moving forward with the first steps towards creating a healthy and happy baby.
Transparent costs	Services for third-party IVF
Can your chosen fertility clinic give you a transparent, upfront cost breakdown once you choose your path to parenthood—including costs for 'what if?' scenarios? If not, you may want to look elsewhere. Fertility services can be expensive, but they should not be surprising or creep up over time.	If you're interested in third-party reproduction services such as egg donation or surrogacy, check that your prospective fertility clinic has direct links with an experienced egg donation and surrogacy agency. Doing this ahead of time makes your life easier; you stand to simplify your journey and avoid more extended, expensive fertility services.
Flexible loan programs	A proven track record
